

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
May 7, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on May 7, 2024. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Wright were present. Atty. Lyons and Kevin Sokol were also in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented, noting one spelling correction that will be made.

Roadmaster Report:

Sale of the F 350 pick-up truck was discussed. It was decided to keep the pick-up for the year and reevaluate it when the next inspection is due.

The culvert pipe on Mulls Hollow and County Line has been damaged by PPL trucks during transmission line reconstruction. PPL will be contacted to turn in a damage claim.

The Subdivision Ordinance was discussed, with Allred making recommendations. Atty. Lyons will continue to incorporate the changes for consideration.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to adopt Driveway Ordinance #2024-1. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to adopt Fee Resolution #24-02, Driveway Permit Fees Charged to the Public.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to accept the quote from Akita LLC Security, option 2, to install an office door buzzer with 2 way communications.

Floodplain administration options were discussed.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to accept the highest bid on Municibid for the Bomford Boom Mower with a bid ending date of May 10, 2024.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to designate by Proclamation May 19 – 25, 2024 as EMS Week.

The Board gave approval for the Secretary to attend the PSTAS Secretary's Summit.

The Animal Ordinance adopted in 1997 was discussed with Atty. Lyons. He will review the Ordinance for consideration at the next meeting.

Checks 5673-5704 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$70,193.58. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.
