

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
June 4, 2024**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 4, 2024. Supervisors Reitz and Allred were present. Supervisor Wright was absent.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

An executive session was called to discuss a legal issue. Executive session ended at 7:20 PM.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Atty. Lyons and Allred continue to work on revisions to the Subdivision Ordinance.

With the resignation of both the roadmaster and equipment operator at the end of June and July, hiring for the positions was discussed.

Atty. Lyons reviewed the Animal Ordinance and recommended not repealing it. After discussing his recommendation the board agreed to leave it in place at this time.

The Board discussed the Subdivision Ordinance with Atty. Lyons in relation to private roads when new subdivisions occur on them. Specifically Whitetail Lane was discussed, and in such a situation where the private drive existed prior to new development that is using the existing drive as access, the board concurred with Atty. Lyons that this is not subject to the Ordinance upgrade specifications.

The Board discussed the current Equipment and Personnel Sharing Agreement with neighboring municipalities as it was brought to their attention that East Buffalo Township would like to add an amendment to include a joint bidding arrangement. The Board is in favor of moving forward with adding the amendment.

It was noted by the secretary that the roof is leaking again. The contractor will be contacted to fix it again.

Checks 5705-5730 were presented for payment with bills totaling 41,158.98. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 PM was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.
