

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
July 2, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on July 2, 2024. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Wright were present. Also in attendance were Gregg Wagner, Rick Wetzel, Ben Wetzel, and Matthew Sherwood. Attendance sheet is also attached.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Members of the Fire Company attended the meeting to present the Board with an update on the budget and fundraisers.

Public Comment:

Mary Moser, a Trutt Road resident, attended the meeting with storm water runoff concerns. It was also mentioned that there are trees needing to be trimmed on Trutt Road. The Roadmaster will work with Mrs. Moser to address the storm water concerns and her driveway. It was reiterated by the Board that the Township will not be responsible for paying for any improvements to a driveway.

Becky Perez and Rachel Waugh with the Union County Library attended the meeting to notify the Board that the library trustees are looking for input from the community on library services offered. Discussion was held on some of the less known services offered and the Board gave personal suggestions.

The Subdivision Ordinance was again discussed. Atty. Lyons will be absent at the August meeting. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to authorize Atty. Lyons to advertise the new Subdivision Ordinance for public hearing and enactment at the September meeting. Bruce Boynton attended the meeting on behalf of the Planning Commission to clarify with the Board the number of users allowed on a private drive as per the Ordinance. The Board maintained the position that private drives that were established before the Ordinance was in place are grandfathered even if new development on them occurs. The Board will review section F 1-8 of the appendix for further clarification in the new Ordinance at the August meeting.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to appoint Matthew Sherwood as the new Roadmaster.

Checks 5731-5754 were presented for payment with bills totaling 12,813.33. A motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 PM was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.
