

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
August 6, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on August 6, 2024. Supervisors Reitz, Allred, and Wright were present. Also in attendance were Mary Moser, Gwen Hall, and the Roadmaster. Atty. Lyons was absent.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

Mary Moser of Trutt Road attended the meeting regarding her driveway upgrades and storm water run-off. The Board and Roadmaster along with Mrs. Moser came to an agreement on the proposed scope of work to be done on the driveway. The cost of the driveway upgrade will be the property owner's responsibility. The township will maintain the clean out of the inlet and outlet as with all driveway pipes that are affected by road water.

The Board was made aware that the Sterling and Western Star trucks are in need of significant maintenance and an estimate was received from Maust Garage. The Board gave approval to move forward with whatever is needed to keep them safe and ready for the winter.

The stormwater pipe at the intersection of Mulls Hollow Road and County Line Road was discussed. A proposal was received from Mid-State Paving for 11,524.00 to replace the pipe and re-pave. The Board agreed that the pipe is damaged and needs to be replaced. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to accept the proposal.

The Roadmaster was given the authorization to hire a laborer to mow and trim as needed at the laborer rate of 17.85 per hour.

Tree trimming on Stein Lane South was discussed. A stop sign ahead sign was installed there as well. The property owner will be notified again that the trees need to be cut back or the township will be trimming them at our own discretion.

The memo regarding Bid Rock Paving that was discussed during executive session at the June meeting was reviewed. It will be signed by the Chairman and is recorded that we will not be accepting bids from Big Rock Paving next year.

The SALDO was again discussed. Allred will discuss some concerns with Atty. Lyons. The Board agreed that we are not prepared to advertise the Ordinance for the September meeting. We are also required to give the Planning Commission 30 days to review any changes before enacting. Discussion has been tabled until the next meeting when Atty. Lyons is present.

The Board was presented with the SEO DEP Reconstructive Planning Municipal Guidance as requested by the Sewage Enforcement Officer.

Checks 5755 – 5788 were presented for payment with bills totaling 24,197.28. A motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 10:00 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
