

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
October 1, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on October 1, 2024. Supervisors Reitz and Wright were present. Allred was absent. Atty. Lyons and Matthew Sherwood were also in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, and seconded by Todd Wright to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report – The Board discussed many issues with the Roadmaster including preparing equipment for snow, truck repairs, radios for the trucks, tree trimming, personnel for the winter season, entry door replacement estimates, and LED lights for the shop. After reviewing a quote from the electrician to replace the fluorescent lights in the shop with LED, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, and seconded by Todd Wright to accept the proposal at 1710.00.

The Speed Limit Ordinance was reviewed on behalf of a resident requesting additional posting on Amish Road South. The Board agreed that putting up more signs is not an effective way to reduce speed and they are not in favor of adding them at this location.

A use agreement between East Buffalo Township, Lewisburg Borough and Union Township to utilize a brush chipper owned by EBT was reviewed by Atty. Lyons and Craig Purdy. At this time Atty. Lyons will work with Atty. Matson on some concerns with the agreement. The matter is tabled until the November meeting.

Atty. Lyons reviewed the insurance requirements of the Multi Municipal Equipment and Personnel Sharing Agreement and it has been noted that the Twp. policy needs to be updated to add a waiver of subrogation endorsement.

A request for a waiver of the PA Code, Chapter 72.33, 100 foot well, septic distance requirement was submitted by the property owner at 118 Maplewood Drive, Winfield. After reviewing the request to reduce the isolation distance due to lot size, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, and seconded by Todd Wright to grant the waiver. It was noted by the Board that the final Sewage Planning Module will still have to be approved by DEP.

Bills were presented for payment totaling 43,932.88. A motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, and seconded by Todd Wright.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 PM was made by Tom Reitz and seconded by Todd Wright.
