

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
June 3, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 3, 2025. Supervisors Allred, Reitz and Wright were present. Attendance sheet is also attached.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Todd Wright, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment:

Zane Buss as well as fire company volunteers attended the meeting with concerns about the executive board of the fire company. The concern being that the executive board of the fire company violated the bylaws of the company by wrongfully expelling Buss. Buss expressed the concern that the leadership at the fire company is affecting the attendance of firefighters and medical personnel responding to calls. Atty. Lyons and the Chairman stated that the fire company is an independent organization, separate from the Township Board of Supervisors and the issues within that organization have to be handled internally. The members can file an official written complaint with the Township Board of Supervisors detailing how the bylaws were violated, however the Board of Supervisors cannot get involved at this time.

Fire Company Report:

Rick Wetzel and Greg Wagner attended the meeting with a first quarter report. They presented the budget, a calls report and an update on fund raisers.

Roadmaster Report:

After reviewing estimates to repair the 2008 PJ trailer, quotes for a new flat-bed trailer were presented to the board. A motion to purchase a new trailer from Northpoint Trailer at a cost of 9255.41 with funds transferred from the Equipment Fund was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd wright and carried. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to advertise for sale on Municibid the 2008 PJ trailer without a reserve.

The Subdivision Ordinance discussion was tabled until the next meeting.

The UGI road restoration was discussed. The UGI pipeline replacement project is slated to start in mid-June. There will be an onsite meeting with UGI and Kiely before the project begins.

Checks 6082-6098 were presented for payment with bills totaling 7,666.84. A motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 PM was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.
