

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
August 5, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on August 5, 2025. Supervisors Allred, Reitz, and Wright were present. Atty. Lyons and Secretary, Wendy Yoder was absent. Also in attendance were Aaron Benfer and Jeff Brouse.

The Chairman announced that the meeting was being recorded due to the secretary's absence.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag. Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

Update on the Municipal Lane/ Shirley Drive pipe replacement; East Buffalo Township will be assisting with finishing the project. Allred addressed the height of the inlet box and the back fill surrounding the new pipe. The roadmaster concurred that these changes will be made and EBT will assist.

The roadmaster discussed various pipes that need to be cleaned out and would like to have them flushed with water using the Sunbury Sewage Authority as done in the past. The Board recommended getting an estimate from them prior to scheduling.

Discussion was held on a deteriorated pipe on Groover Drive. The board recommended patching the pipe and if it does not hold we will address it again next year.

The Board discussed the progress of the UGI project.

The windshield on the CAT loader was broken, it has been submitted to insurance and we are waiting for an estimate from CAT to replace it.

Neighbor complaints on Albert Blvd. were again discussed concerning overgrown grass and garbage. Allred addressed the issue by talking to the property owners. The Board has limited ways of enforcing maintenance of personal property.

A response was received from PSATS regarding the resident request for a Cell Tower Ordinance. At this time the Board will not pursue the Ordinance further.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to authorize Atty. Lyons to prepare the Resolution for the 5 County Regional Solid Waste Plan for adoption at the September meeting.

The Union County Sheriff's Canine Unit fund drive for a new Canine Cruiser was discussed. The Board is not in favor of allocating township tax revenue for matters outside of the township.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to reschedule the November meeting for Thursday, November 6th at 7:00 PM.

The fuel log discrepancy was discussed and appears to be an issue with reading and logging the meter correctly. Allred recommended replacing the meter so it is easier to read.

Checks 6124-6149 were presented for payment for a total of 11,694.08. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.
