

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
September 2, 2025**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on September 2, 2025. Supervisors Allred, Reitz, and Wright were present. Ken and Karen Ulrich, and Aaron Benfer were also in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the August meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment:

Ken and Karen Ulrich attended the meeting with concerns about the speed of traffic on SR 304 at the intersection of Stein Lane. The Board discussed the safety issues on SR 304 and will contact Penn DOT as well as PSP requesting a traffic study to possibly lower the speed limit and more patrolling by PSP.

Roadmaster Report:

The brush pile has been chipped. The Roadmaster proposed a fence or barrier to limit access to the brush pile as it is being taken advantage of as well as littered with unwanted materials. Equipment issues were discussed.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the Five County Regional Solid Waste Plan Resolution #25-03 as prepared by Atty. Lyons.

A meeting has been scheduled for Monday, September 22, 2025 with UGI to discuss the construction plan on Trutt and Felmey Roads following completion of the new pipeline installation.

The position of equipment operator was discussed.

Checks 6150-6173 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$37,329.30. A motion to approve the bills as presented was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 PM was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.
