

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
October 7, 2025**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on October 7, 2025. Supervisors Allred, Reitz and Wright were present. Attendance sheet is attached.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: Ryan Haefner attended the meeting to observe as part of a project to obtain his Eagle Scout Badge.

Rick Wetzel, Ben Wetzel and Greg Wagner attended the meeting to give a report for the Fire Company. Updates were given on fund raising, the budget and fire calls.

Justin Edwards with Comcast attended the meeting to discuss a franchise agreement with the Board. Atty. Lyons will review the proposed contract once it is submitted by Comcast.

Roadmaster Report:

The Township drain pipe project is underway. An additional driver for winter snow maintenance was discussed. CAT loader repairs and bill was discussed. The boom mower is inoperable and needs a costly repair. Options for fixing or replacing it have been tabled at this time. The roadmaster discussed fence quotes that he received with different options to secure the brush pile. At this time the wish of the board is to look into closing the site and having it open by appointment only.

Allred gave an update on the SR 304 speed and safety concerns that have been brought to the attention of the board by residents. After contacting PSP and Penn DOT, speed was monitored in Dry Valley for two weeks. Penn DOT will be cutting back brush near the intersection for better visibility and putting up a flashing speed sign for one week in each direction to slow down traffic.

The November meeting was rescheduled for Thursday, November 6, 2025.

Checks 6174 – 6201 were presented for payment with bills totaling 44,277.63. A motion to approve the bills as presented with the exception of the CAT bill which will be questioned, was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 PM was made by Todd Wright, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
