

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
November 6, 2025**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on November 6, 2025. Supervisors Allred, Reitz, and Wright were present, Allred attended by zoom. Jeff Brouse and Aaron Benfer were in attendance.

Tom Reitz called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag. Reitz then presided over the meeting.

Having reviewed the minutes of the October meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

After discussion on re-installation of the old fire siren, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried that it should be turned over to the fire company and they should decide what to do with the siren and whether or not to install it at their cost.

Discussion on the position of township laborer and equipment operator was tabled.

Atty. Lyons had nothing new to report on the Comcast Agreement.

The current agreement between UGI and the township was discussed with Atty. Lyons. The current contract states that the township may terminate it at any time. The board would like to amend the agreement prior to UGI beginning phase two, to cover the details of road restoration. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to send a letter to UGI stating that the township would like to amend the current contract to exclude Big Rock Paving from working within Union Township.

The 2026 proposed budget was discussed. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to accept the proposed budget at \$703,403.00 and to authorize Atty. Lyons to advertise it for adoption at the December meeting.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to authorize Atty. Lyons to prepare the 2026 Tax Resolution with the current millage rates as follows: real estate tax for the General Fund to be fifty hundredths (0.50) of a mill, real estate tax for Fire Protection to be forty-three hundredths (0.43) of a mill, real estate transfer tax to be one-half (1/2) of one (1%) percent, and earned income tax to be one-half (1/2) of one (1%) percent.

A report was given on the county wide reassessment meeting.

Bills were presented for payment with checks 6205-6223 totaling \$25,245.17. A motion to approve the bills as presented was made by Todd Wright, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.

The board went into executive session at 8:30 PM.

A motion to end executive session and adjourn the meeting 9:10 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.
