

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
January 6, 2026**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 6, 2026. Supervisors Allred, Reitz, and Wright were present. Aaron Benfer and Jeremiah Lenker were also in attendance.

The minutes of the December meeting were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried. The minutes of the January 5, 2026 Reorganization meeting were also reviewed. A motion to approve the Reorganization minutes as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Jeremiah Lenker with Isett & Associates attended the meeting to present to the Board their firm information for building code administration, engineering services and floodplain engineering administration.

Roadmaster Report:

A new meter for the fuel tank was again discussed. The Board approved the purchase of a new one. The 2026 project bids were discussed. It was decided for this year to not participate in the combo bid with EBT, due to the ongoing UGI project.

Atty. Lyons updated the Board that there has been no response from UGI on an agreement. The Atty. reiterated that UGI does not have a permit to cut township roads without the agreement. The Board authorized Atty. Lyons to take appropriate action by sending a letter to UGI, should they begin work. It was also agreed upon that moving forward; everything will be in writing prior to granting permission to do any work in the township ROW, including verbal agreements made in 2025.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve the UGI Water Obstruction General Permit as reviewed at the December meeting.

Insurance premiums and renewal were reviewed.

Attendance to the annual PSATS Conference was discussed.

Checks 6248 – 6276 were presented for payment for a total of 59,211.76. Motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.
