

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
August 4, 2026**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on August 4, 2026. Supervisors Allred, Reitz, and Wright were present. Attendance sheet is attached.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the July meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Christian Rosini with UGI attended the meeting, as well as Christian Hofmann with Big Rock, and Calvin Phillips with Ryland Traffic. Mr. Rosini presented a permit application for extending the gas line to another resident on Woodsedge Drive. The Chairman noted that the Attorney for UGI has not returned emails or phone calls to Atty. Lyons regarding the unresolved issue from Phase 1 of the project. The Board would like some communication from UGI's Attorney before moving forward with a new permit. Mr. Rosini told the Board that the top soil and seeding restoration done on Felmey Road will be replaced due to it not germinating. The Township will do a final inspection of the work. Restoration of Phase 2 of Amish and Supplee Mill Roads was also discussed. Rosini agreed that line striping on Amish, Supplee Mill and Fruit Farm will be done as part of the final restoration of this phase. Restoration of Woodsedge was discussed, and the Board expressed their concerns that a 1 ½ inch mill and half width overlay paving was not done on Woodsedge. Rosini responded that it was not restored because it is not their main line. Restoration negotiations will continue.

The Planning Commission Chairman attended the meeting to present concerns expressed by other members regarding additions to the SALDO and zoning. Allred stated the Board of Supervisors is happy to discuss zoning concerns with the Planning Commission. The Chairman has been reviewing the SALDO. It will be added to the agenda for the next meeting when Atty. Lyons is present.

Roadmaster Report:

RM requested the purchase of socket sets and an impact drill. The board approved the purchase at a max budget of 1000.

RM is looking at the trucks to get ready for winter maintenance. The Chairman noted that summer mowing should be prioritized and also to continue communication with the Board.

Supervisor Reitz inspected Supplee Mill Road pipes during heavy rainfall and did not see an issue with storm water pipes in question. He also noted that the ditches need cleaned out.

Road Opening Ordinance revisions were discussed and will be given to Atty. Lyons.

Supervisor Wright, the Secretary and Roadmaster will meet onsite at 687 Trutt Road on August 6, 2026 to further discuss resident concerns.

Goodhart Circle concerns are tabled until Atty. Lyons is present.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve attendance and to pay all expenses of the Chairman at the PSATS's Chairman's Retreat.

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Checks 6424 – 6445 were presented for payment for a total of 19,882.48. Motion to approve bills as presented was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 10:00 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.
