ORDINANCE NO. 85-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE NO. 80-1, ENACTED AUGUST 5, 1980, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 81-1, ENACTED FEBRUARY 3, 1981, WHICH AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION TO ENTER INTO A JOINT MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITH THE BOROUGH OF LEWISBURG, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY INCREASING THE RATE TO BE PAID THE BOROUGH OF LEWISBURG FOR THE SERVICES PERFORMED UNDER THE SAID AGREEMENT TO THIRTY (\$30.00) DOLLARS PER MAN-HOUR; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 83-1, ENACTED FEBRUARY 1, 1983.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Union, Union County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, in accordance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of 1972, July 12, No. 180 [53 P.S. §481 et seq.], as follows:

Section 1. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 80-1, enacted August 5, 1980, as amended by Ordinance No. 81-1, enacted February 3, 1981, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 9. The Township shall pay the Borough of Lewisburg for the services performed under the said Agreement the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per man-hour, payable monthly according to the detailed statement of charges to be furnished by the Borough of Lewisburg within ten (10) days of the end of each month."

Section 2. Except as amended by this Ordinance and Ordinance No. 81-1, enacted February 3, 1981, all of the provisions of Ordinance No. 80-1, enacted August 5, 1980, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 83-1, enacted February 1, 1983, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective February 16, 1985, being more than five (5) days after enactment hereof.
