

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
March 5, 2019

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 5, 2019 with all Supervisors present. Also in attendance were Bruce Boynton Planning Commission, Chris Benfer UTFC, Jeff Brouse, and Nelson Poe.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Committee Reporting:

- Chris Benfer with the UTFC presented the Board with an update on fund raising events, trucks and apparatus, fire calls, and the annual budget.
- Planning Commission Chairman, Bruce Boynton attended the meeting to present the Board with an updated Sub-Division Ordinance to review. The Board will review the changes and plan a work day if necessary before approval is given to adopt the amendments.

The LVDGR Grant through the Union County Conservation Office was discussed in relation to upgrading Maplewood Drive. At this time it was decided to only install the underdrain and pipes that would be presumably reimbursed by the grant.

The proposed road projects were discussed including Maplewood Drive, Supplee Mill Road, Stein Lane, Felmey Road, Shirley Drive, and Timberwood Drive, as well as Municipal Lane, the parking lot and the recycling pad expansion. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to advertise for bids the projects as attached. Only the pipes will be replaced on Supplee Mill Road this year. It will be considered again for paving next year.

The Roadmaster mentioned other patching and pipe replacement projects that will be done throughout the Township with our own forces.

Checks 4086-4113 were presented for payment with bills totaling 33,218.21. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve the bills as presented.

Motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 PM.
