

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
February 2, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on February 2, 2021. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Bieber were present. Atty. Lyons was available by phone. Also in attendance were Jeff Brouse and Atty. Brian Kerstetter.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the January 4, 2021 reorganization meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the reorganization minutes. After also reviewing the minutes of the January 4, 2021 regular meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Roadmaster Report:

The Roadmaster brought it to the attention of the Board that the salt spreader on the pickup truck is in need of a new chain at a cost of approximately \$3000.00. An estimate of \$5000.00 was also received for a whole new unit including the motor. After discussion including plans to purchase a different truck in the future, the Board agreed to replace the chain only at this time. Potential summer road projects were also discussed.

Public Comment:

Atty. Brian Kerstetter attended the meeting to make known his intent to run for Union and Snyder County Common Pleas Judge.

The William Street project was discussed and the bid package will be prepared for approval at the March meeting.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to advertise the roof replacement bid to be opened at the March 2, 2021 meeting. The bid will be for replacement with a Fabral metal roof and the specs will be changed to require that a snow bars system is used instead of snow guards.

Discussion was held on the neighboring property at 417 Park Road that is for sale. The Board agreed that there is no functional use for the property to the Township and that they will not be making an offer to purchase it.

After hearing concerns from a property owner on Trutt Road regarding the pipe installation project that was just completed there, the drain issues will be looked at by the Roadmaster and Supervisor Bieber.

Checks 4727-4751 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$74,311.92. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn at 9:00 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
