

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
June 1, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 1, 2021. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Bieber were present. Atty. Lyons, Jeff Brouse and Charles Axtman were also in attendance. Attendance sheet is also attached.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the minutes of the meeting as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

- The Board approved the generator maintenance contract for 2022 with the addition of replacing the battery.
- The mower repairs are complete.
- The roof replacement is almost complete.
- Paving will begin the end of June.

A Floodplain Ordinance webinar hosted by PEMA was attended by the Chairman, Secretary and Township Engineer. The Chairman discussed building and floodplain permit requirements as mandated by FEMA to administer the NFIP.

David Ulrich with Mid-Penn Engineering attended the meeting representing the Trutt's regarding their property located on Lee's Lane. After much discussion the Board agreed that new construction at the property could occur but the plan must show no rise and must comply with the revised Floodplain Ordinance.

Further discussion on the Floodplain Ordinance was held with Mr. Axtman. Permits, reporting and record keeping were discussed and more regular on-site inspections will be conducted by the engineer.

The Twp. Engineer and Supervisor Bieber inspected the outlet pipe on SR 304 and Park Rd. that was brought up as a concern by a resident. It was confirmed by this meeting that the pipe, coming from State Roads, is not the responsibility of the Township. The outlet on private property is the responsibility of the property owner.

An inspection of the Winfield Storage Units was conducted due to a resident concern. The fill being placed is within the plan and permit, however an additional permit will need to be obtained for the stabilizing rock on the stream bank.

The estimates for the Township/ Fire Company sign were again reviewed. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to accept the quote from Middle Creek Signs with the addition of posts with vinyl sleeves.

Atty. Lyons will be absent at the August meeting.

Checks 4823 – 4845 were presented for payment for a total of \$10,618.84. A motion was made by Mark Bieber, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 PM was made by Mark Bieber, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.
