

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
August 3, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on August 3, 2021. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Bieber were present. Also in attendance were Roadmaster, Jeff Brouse and Greg Wagner. Atty. Lyons was absent.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Greg Wagner attended representing the Fire Company to present a financial update on the new truck fund.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

- There was a leak in the new roof in the shop. The contractor came back to look at it and fixed the issue.
- Ditches have been cleaned out and trees will be trimmed this week.
- The Roadmaster mentioned that the drain pipe replacement on Stein Lane South is on the fall schedule.
- The seeding on William Street will be completed this month.

Discussion was held on a follow up from Eddy Koebke with the Keystone Insurance Group. It was decided that the service from our current agent has been good and there is no need to change agents at this time.

A meeting will be scheduled with Penn DOT regarding the Mulls Hollow North maintenance issue.

After much discussion on a road name change for the northern section of Mulls Hollow Road, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to rename that portion Gobbler Road. This road name change is being done in support of the local utilities and emergency responders to alleviate confusion between the northern and southern sections created during the CSVT project.

Half of the American Relief Funds were received in the amount of \$84,520.39. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to authorize the Secretary to set up a new account in PLGIT to transfer the funds into. The Board wishes to remain patient in deciding on a use for the funds. A meeting will be held on August 25th at the Government Center with the County Commissioners and other Township Officials to discuss possible projects and allowed uses of the money.

Penn DOT gave the Township notification that they no longer allow new Deer Crossing signs to be put up as they have been deemed unsafe.

The Secretary followed up with GIS and the Post Office regarding the address issue with Jackson Township, Snyder County located at 57 Municipal Road, Winfield. Seeing that the issue is with Google maps, GIS put in a change order. Supervisor Allred also made a change order with Google. The issue still remains.

Act 65 of 2021 mandates posting of all Municipal agendas on both the Township website and the door of the meeting location, at least 24 hours prior to a meeting. The Board discussed the details of the new law.

Checks 4877 – 4893 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$7,806.53. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the bills as presented.

Motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 PM.
