

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
September 5, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on September 5, 2023. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Bieber were present. Also in attendance were Atty. Lyons, Kevin Sokol, Ben Wetzel and Greg Wagner.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Representing the Fire Company, Ben Wetzel and Greg Wagner reported on calls, fund raising, camp ground progress, and the budget.

Roadmaster Report:

Estimates were received for repair and installation of guide rails on Felmey Road. Several small paving issues were discussed and will be fixed by Fairchild Brothers. All culvert pipe repairs on Felmey Road are completed. Penn DOT will address the tie in issue on Stein Lane and SR 304.

A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to record that the Board made a Disaster Declaration on August 7, 2023 due to storm damage throughout the Township.

The Driveway Ordinance was tabled until next month.

The floodplain and sewage issues on South Riverbreeze Avenue were discussed with Atty. Lyons. It was decided to have the SEO and the Floodplain Engineer do an on-site inspection of the property, accompanied by a uniformed officer. Notice is to be given to the property owner of the time and date of the inspection.

Atty. Lyons reviewed the Non CDL Drug Policy with the Board. Supervisor Allred will get a draft to Atty. Lyons for final approval at the next meeting.

The UCATO Convention will be held on October 26, 2023.

A resident concern regarding the sidewalks in downtown Winfield was brought to the attention of the Board. Atty. Lyons noted that there are no Ordinances in Union Township regarding sidewalks and that they are owned by the property owners and are the sole responsibility of the property owners.

A letter from the CKCOG regarding inspection safety was reviewed.

Checks 5470-5495 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$78,346.04. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve bills as presented.
