

**Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
December 5, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on December 5, 2023. Supervisors Reitz and Allred were present. Supervisor Bieber was absent. Also in attendance were Atty. Lyons, Todd Wright and Kevin Sokol.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the November meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Motion to adopt the final 2024 budget and to authorize Atty. Lyons to advertise it as adopted was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.

Motion to adopt Tax Resolution #23-04 retaining taxes at the existing rates as listed in the November minutes was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried.

The septic issue at Goodhart Circle was discussed with Atty. Lyons. The Board will give the property owner one more month to make progress on installing the holding tanks before moving forward with prosecution.

The 2024 meeting dates and times were set for the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM with the exception of the January regular meeting, which will be held on January 9, 2024 at 7:00 PM. The Reorganization meeting will be held on January 2, 2024 at 8:00 AM. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to set the meeting dates and times and to authorize Atty. Lyons to advertise.

Motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to extend the per diem pay for all PSATS trainings to Supervisors in addition to the PSATS Convention.

Insurance renewal quote was reviewed. Motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to accept the insurance renewal and Statement of Values as presented.

The Sunshine Act agenda laws were discussed with Atty. Lyons.

Allred recognized the service that resigning Supervisor Mark Bieber has provided the Township for the last six years. He will be presented with a Certificate of Service from PSATS in appreciation.

Checks 5547-5566 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$13,038.98. Motion to approve bills as presented was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
