

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
January 9, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the union Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 9, 2024. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Wright were present. Also in attendance were Rick Wetzel, Ben Wetzel, Greg Wagner, Gary Brouse and Kevin Sokol.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the minutes as presented. The minutes of the January 2, 2024 Reorganization meeting were then reviewed. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

The Fire Company Chief, President and Treasurer attended the meeting to present the Board with a 2023 report and to give updates on 2024 fund raisers and events.

EMC Gary Brouse attended the meeting to introduce himself to the new Supervisor as well as to notify the Board of a training he will be conducting.

Roadmaster Report:

Down spouting on the new salt shed was discussed. The Board will look at the issue to see if it needs added.

The Roadmaster and Board discussed the issue of contractors abusing the use of the brush pile. Quotes were presented for fencing in the area. Fencing is being put on hold for now. The Board suggested putting up a larger sign and camera for the time being.

A letter from the SEO on the Goodhart Circle septic issue was reviewed by Atty. Lyons. The owner has been compliant with the SEO requirements as of now and Brown will follow up in the spring.

The Subdivision Ordinance updates were again discussed. Questions on subdivisions throughout the township were reviewed with Atty. Lyons. The Board reiterated that any resident can bring Planning Commission decisions to the Board for review if a decision is being questioned.

Allred discussed the amount of political campaign signs around the fire company building, in the yard and walk way to the door of the polls. It was decided to write a letter to the fire company (polling location) requesting that they ask the Jude of Elections to not allow signs in the grass area, beside the sidewalk into the building as this has become problematic for residents to get to the polls. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to send the request letter limiting the location of campaign signs to the driveway area beside the road only.

The CKCOG employee weapons policy was reviewed.

Checks 5567 – 5593 were presented for payment for a total of \$40,110.25. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the bills as presented.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
