

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes Regular Meeting
March 5, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 5, 2024. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Wright were present. Kevin Sokol and Atty. Lyons were also present.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Todd Wright and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

The Subdivision and Driveway Ordinances were discussed. Atty. Lyons met with the Planning Commission Chairman on some issues that will be further discussed by the two Boards at a later date. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to authorize Atty. Lyons to draft a Driveway Ordinance for review by the Board at the next meeting. Atty. Lyons and Allred will continue to work on changes to the Subdivision Ordinance.

Road projects were discussed. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to advertise for bids all of the proposed projects with a bid opening date at the next meeting on April 2, 2024.

The remaining ARP funds were discussed and a motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to designate \$10,000.00 of the remaining funds to the Fire Company truck fund and the balance of \$8,851.93 to 2024 road projects.

The County gave notification of a new recycling grant round. Potential site improvements were discussed, including anti-skid paint for the wooden platform and a security camera for the brush pile area.

Supervisor Wright brought up the need for office security and discussed some options for improving on that. The Board agreed to move forward with getting estimates for an office window and a door buzzer.

Checks 5619-5645 were presented for payment with bills totaling 21,662.12. A motion to approve bills as presented was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Todd Wright and carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 PM was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried.
