

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
July 7, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on July 7, 2020 with all Supervisors present. Atty. Lyons and Jeffery Brouse were also in attendance. Attendance sheet is also attached.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment:

Lynn Napp attended the meeting to make the Board aware of potential safety issues with the guard rails on Felmev Road. The roadmaster noted that the guard rails are on the schedule to be replaced after the pipe replacements on Felmev are completed.

Roadmaster Report:

- The paving project is completed.
- An electrical issue with the transfer switch on the generator was repaired.
- Chipping is scheduled for the end of July.

Updates to the Floodplain Ordinance that will be required by FEMA for the Flood Insurance Rate Maps were discussed. Atty. Lyons noted that we should verify what changes, if any, are required. The Township will have six months from the time of the notification letter to make the necessary changes.

The William Street project was discussed and it was decided to move forward with requesting a construction easement where it will be necessary to detour traffic through a private ROW during the project. Estimates will also be needed to put together a project bid package.

A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to adopt Resolution #20-04, updating the Union County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Checks 4540 – 4569 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$17,111.82. A motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 PM.
