

Union Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes/ Regular Meeting
March 1, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 1, 2022. Supervisors Reitz, Allred and Bieber were present. Jeff Brouse and Atty. Lyons were also in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Having reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the minutes as presented.

Public Comment: None

Roadmaster Report:

- The Roadmaster will be gathering initial quotes for a salt shed addition.
- Finding a T-Tag truck was again discussed. Nothing is available through the COSTARS program at this time, with a two year wait on orders. The Board gave approval for the Roadmaster to continue to look for trucks outside of COSTARS.
- The Mulls Hollow South intersection at County Line Road needs attention. The Roadmaster will work with Monroe Township on ROW to replace the drain pipe.

Project estimates were reviewed. No news has been received from Penn DOT yet on Gobbler Road. The Board would like to do a road tour prior to advertising for the projects. The decision will be on hold until the next meeting.

The updates to the Subdivision Ordinance were again discussed.

American Rescue Plan funds were discussed. The lost revenue category can be used for more flexibility with spending the funds. Billy Allred noted the letter from CKCOG requesting funds from member Townships because they remained open during Covid but have not been eligible for any government assistance. No final decisions have been made on allocating the funds.

The Sewage Planning Module for William Meek on Felmey Road was reviewed by the Board. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Billy Allred and carried to approve the module.

The Sewage Planning Module for Christy Young was reviewed. Based on approval by the SEO, a motion was made by Billy Allred, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve the module.

Motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to adopt Resolution #22-03 authorizing Penn DOT to request railroad crossing upgrades at T-369, Riverbreeze Avenue from the PA PUC.

A motion was made by Mark Bieber, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to authorize the Secretary to execute an approval letter to Penn DOT for the railroad crossing upgrades for the same.

Checks 5037-5056 were presented for payment with bills totaling \$37,718.78. A motion was made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to approve bills as presented.

Motion made by Tom Reitz, seconded by Mark Bieber and carried to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 PM.
